How We Protect Your Privacy

This notice is given on behalf of all members of the Mt. Morris Mutual Insurance Company, including our Insurance Agents and Affiliates.

This notice is to inform you, our valued policyholder, how we, The Mt. Morris Mutual Insurance Company, collect, disclose, and protect your nonpublic personal financial information.

Collecting Information to Conduct Our Business

The Mt. Morris Mutual Insurance Company collects, retains, and uses nonpublic personal financial information about you for the purpose of serving your insurance needs in the best interest of you, the policyholder, and to build our customer relationships. We may collect personal information about you from the following sources:

- Direct personal information we receive from you on applications, endorsements, or other forms, legal documents, or in response to verbal requests for information from you. This information includes, but is not limited to, your assets, income, and personal identifying information such as your name and address.
- Information about your consumer transactions with us or others, such as prior policies purchased and premium payment history.
- Information we receive from a consumer-reporting agency such as your credit worthiness and credit history.

How We May Disclose Your Information

The Mt. Morris Mutual Insurance Company does not disclose nonpublic personal financial information about our customers or former customers to affiliated or nonaffiliated third parties except as permitted by law and necessary to conduct business.

How We Protect the Confidentiality & Security of Your Nonpublic Personal Financial Information

The Mt. Morris Mutual Insurance Company restricts access to your nonpublic personal financial information to those employees, affiliates, and Insurance Agents who need to know the information to provide products and/or services to you. We maintain physical, electronic, and procedural safeguards that are in compliance with applicable federal regulations to safeguard your nonpublic personal financial information.
